

# The Aquarian Teacher POLICY

TTEC April 2011

## Policy:

- Implementation of New CONTENT CREDIT qualification system within Units of Study to demonstrate proficiency
- Once a Trainer qualifies for a subject in CONTENT CREDITS they can teach it.
- Professionals and Lead Trainers who qualified prior to April 2011 are qualified for 100% of the CONTENT CREDITS. Associates who qualified prior to April 2011 are qualified for at least 25% of the CONTENT CREDITS.
- Demonstrated competency to deliver the material on stage in a Teacher Training environment has been separated from mastery of content
- The percentage of the program content required to move from Associate to Professional has changed from the full curriculum to 50% of the curriculum.
- Professionals who wish to become Lead Trainers must qualify for 100% of the CONTENT CREDITS including Western Anatomy.
- The percentage of the program a Professional is allowed to teach unsupervised in a single program has changed from 80% to 50%.
- A Professional now maintains a relationship with a Mentoring Lead.
- A written Mentor / Mentee Operating Agreement will be required from all new Intern Applicants.
- All members of the Academy, including Interns and Associates, will be required to attend a Trainer Forum at least every other year.
- Reminder: all new applicants to the Academy or all candidates moving to the next level in the Academy must have completed all 5 Level Two modules.
